Raised in rural Iowa at the end of the nineteenth century, Leopold was inspired by the Progressive conservationists, made led by President Theodore Roosevelt and Gifford Pinchot, Forest Chief of the U.S. Department of the Interior. He joined the fledgling Forest Service and spent a lifetime in public service devoted to conservation. After coming to Wisconsin in the 1930s, he showed his private land use practices while remaining a conservationist from Wisconsin, one manifested by a private foundation as a model of ecological prudence. 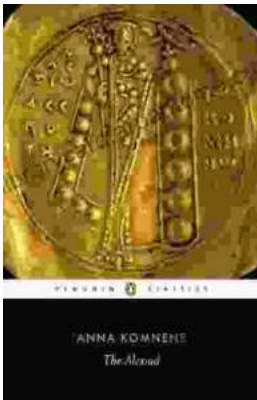
