Aldo Leopold was dedicated to restoring the health of the land. Raised in steel-hour at the end of the nineteenth century, Leopold was inspired by the Progressive conservation movement, founded by President Theodore Roosevelt and Gifford Pinchot, then Chief of the U.S. Forest Service. He joined the fledgling Forest Service and spent 20 years in public service dedicated to conservation. After moving to Wisconsin in the 1920s, he followed the private land-use guidelines while restoring a 160-acre farm in southwest Wisconsin, now known as a model of ecological restoration. For many years, he was a professor of ecology, management at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. His last field trip in 1948 while fighting a forest fire in a neighbor's home.

Leopold remains among the most influential ecologists of the twentieth century. As Chief of the Forest Service, Leopold knew that Aldo Leopold's vision had to be translated into our policies and practices. He explored the concept of "A Land Ethic,"

the idea of environmental stewardship. While the natural resource policies Leopold imagined, the principles of wildlife management as a field of science and its importance for the welfare of ecosystems, the field ecology, the theory and practice of ecosystem-based management, and much more.


