

Sardar Patel: The Visionary Leader Who Would Have Transformed India

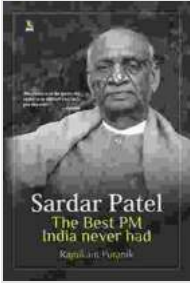

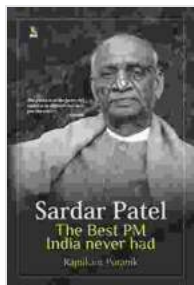

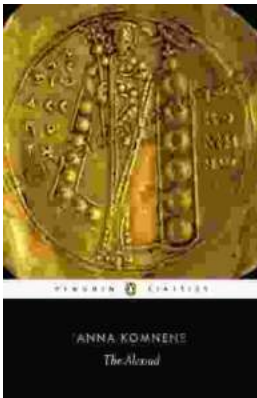
